I miss everything and especially Serra (a student from Turkey who

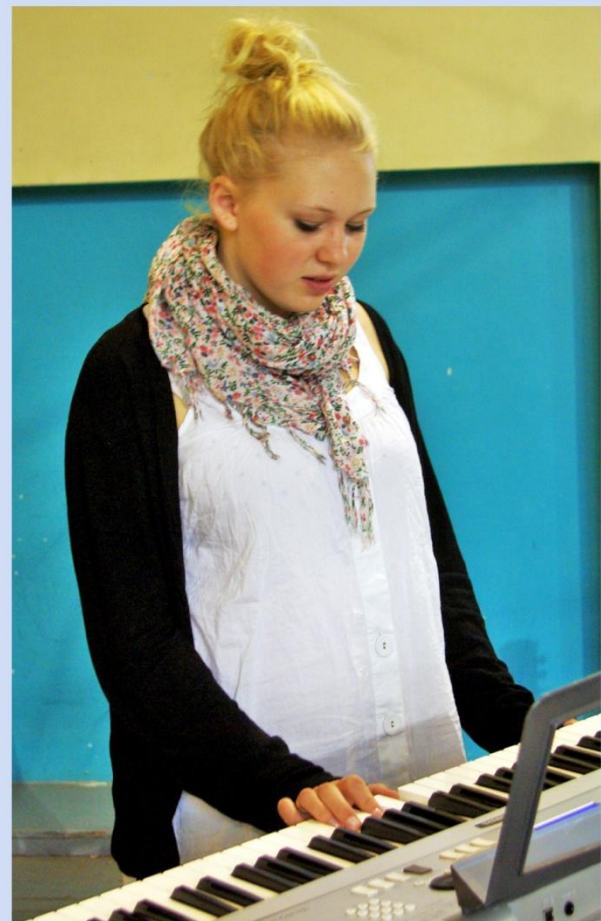
was studying at Andebølle the same semester of Belinda). I also remember how my relationship with Daniel started.
