I miss the people that I spent my time with and the

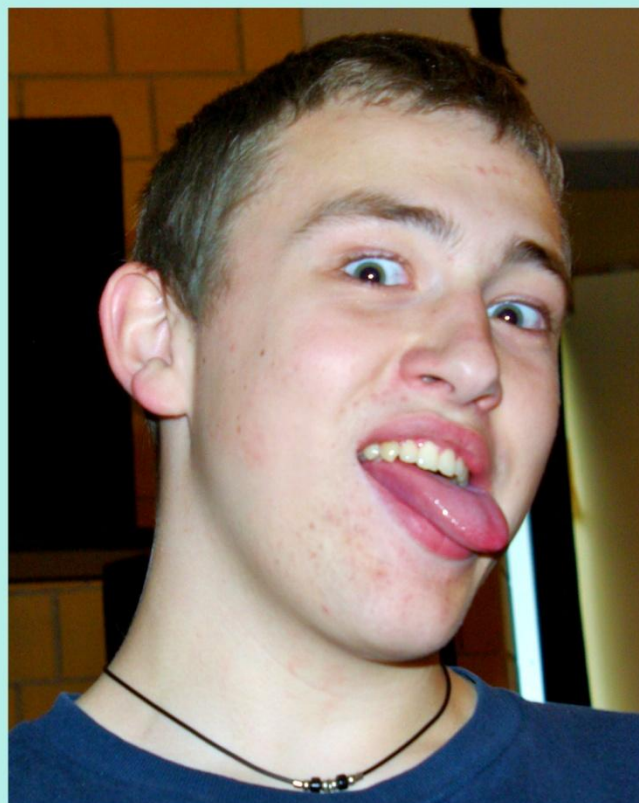
teachers. The one thing I remember the most is the Theatre class. It was the first time I was doing that (stage fright!).
