I liked pretty much everything, not much to

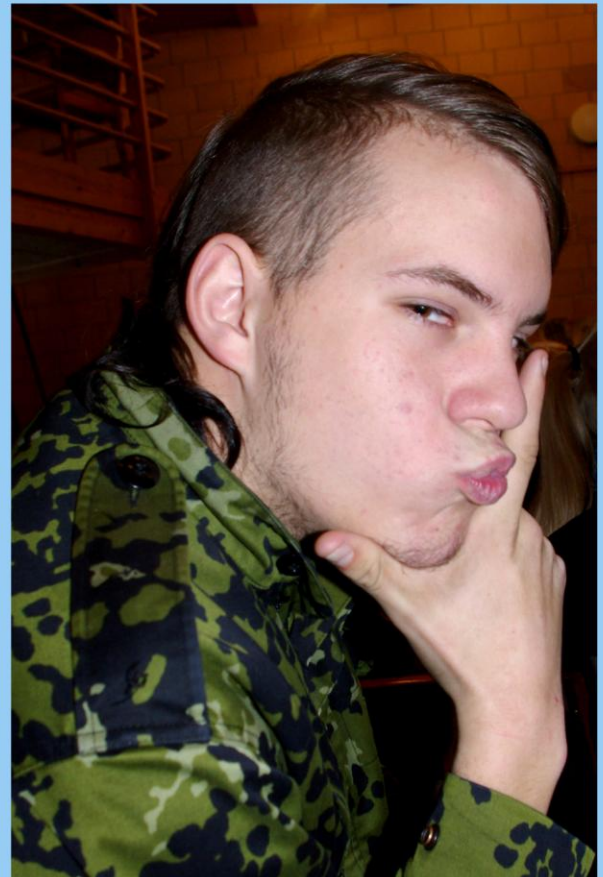
dislike about Andebølle.
