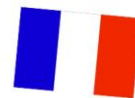


Intercultural Evening at Andebølle

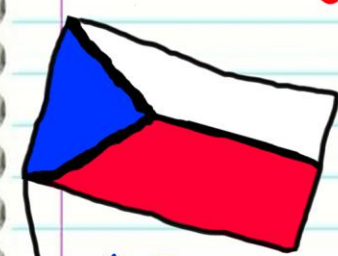

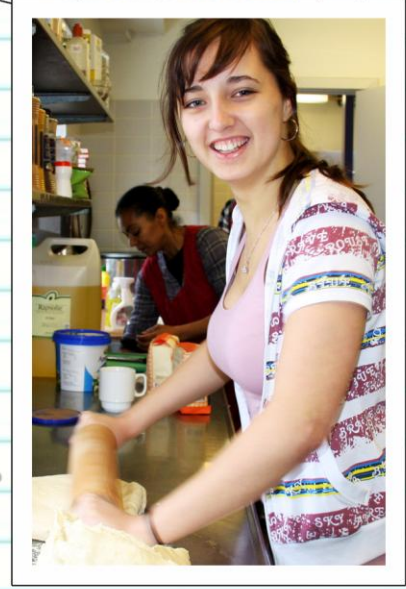
Today is Czech day!!
